Your AccessID (e.g. xy1234) is your key to accessing all of Wayne State University's tech services—Wi-Fi, Academica, email and more!
- Set up WSU-SECURE Wi-Fi on your devices**
Connect to the Wi-Fi network WSU-SECURE and log in with your AccessID and password on your smartphone, laptop, tablet and other devices. Find more detailed instructions at go.wayne.edu/securesetup.
- Set up Broadcast Messaging**
Sign up for text messages and emails to notify you about events like emergency weather closures: broadcast.wayne.edu.
- Plug in for printing**
Wireless printers interfere with WSU's wireless network. If your printer has a wireless capability, disable the feature and connect with a USB cable—they are available for purchase at the C&IT Help Desk.
- Buy an Ethernet switch**
Personal routers are forbidden in residence halls because they interfere with the wireless network. The C&IT Help Desk offers Ethernet switches and cables for purchase.
- Download/install anti-virus software**
C&IT recommends downloading anti-virus software. Find instructions at kb.wayne.edu/97915.
- Download FREE Microsoft Office**
Currently registered WSU students can receive a free full copy of Microsoft Office: go.wayne.edu/office.
- Register your devices**
If your gaming device, smart TV or other internet-capable device is not compatible with WSU-SECURE, you may register them to connect to WSU-LIMITED: go.wayne.edu/deviceregistration.
- Disable power save mode on your laptop**
Power Save Polling (PSP) mode provides extended battery life for laptop computers: kb.wayne.edu/205760.
- Set up your TV and streaming**
Comcast provides television service in residence halls and apartments: go.wayne.edu/tv. Xfinity on campus streaming is available to Wayne State residents: go.wayne.edu/streaming.



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
